## Club apparel & merchandise

To order apparel or merchandise:

- Log into the Member's Zone (membership-log in option in drop-down box).
- Once logged in, hover your mouse over the Member's Zone tab, and select "Apparel" from the drop-down listing.



- Available apparel and merchandise items will be shown.
- If you wish to purchase non-sized apparel or other merchandise, click on the item then click on the “Add to Cart” button.
- If you wish to purchase sized apparel, click on the item. Select the appropriate HDT logo colour for your HDT (black/red for VC, VH and Magnum, blue/red for VK and VL). Most items will have a mens’ fit and womens’ fit, so select the appropriate gender from the drop- down list. Depending on which gender has been chosen, appropriate sizes will show in the Size box. Select your size from the drop-down listing. Note: a sizing chart showing male and female measurements is available on each listing for sized apparel (jackets/dress shirt/polo shirt) – please check your measurements against this if you are not sure which size you require.
- Once done, click the “Add to Cart” button.
- Your shopping cart with all purchases will be shown. Shipping costs are a flat rate across Australia. Review your order and, when satisfied, click on the Proceed to Checkout button.
- Check that your billing and delivery addresses are correct, then click on Place Order button and follow the instructions to finalise your purchase.
- If the apparel coordinator has your requested item/s in stock, it/they will be posted to you. If something needs to be ordered from our apparel supplier, this will be done and your item/s will be posted to you.
