**Judged Entry:** Cost is \$40 for a regular judged entry, this includes car and driver. Any passengers will need to purchase a General Entry ticket at \$10pp. There are also extra categories shown for further judging (Paintwork, Custom Graphics, Engine Bay, Interior, Wheels, Stereo); each category will cost an extra \$10 per category on top of the initial \$40. **Registrations for judged entries will close on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> March.**

**Show Entry (not judged):** Cost is \$20 for car and driver. Any passengers will need to purchase a General Entry ticket at \$10pp.
